



## *European Open SN Judo Games 202 - Ireland*

*14th - 17th October 2010*

- Date & Time:** Saturday 17th October - competition starts at 10am
- Venue:** Nenagh Community College Sports Arena, Nenagh, Tipperary, Ireland
- Organisers:** Judo Assist Ireland and International Special Needs Judo Union (SNJU)
- Registration Deadline:** **10th September 2021 - The maximum number of participants is 200 persons**
- Participation Fee:** €20 (this fee includes lunch pack for athletes on the day of contest)
- Participation fee must be paid by the club/organisation for all athletes in one transaction and can be paid by bank transfer or paypal payment by the registration date. Alternatively the fees can be paid in cash at check-in. if you take this option you must pay for all registered athletes regardless whether they compete/travel or not.
- Eligible to participate:** All SNJU events are fully inclusive and are open to people with all disabilities including be not limited to intellectual & physical, social disabilities and hearing and sight impairments.
- Contest Format:** We will be operating the pool system with 4/5 persons in each pool. All competitors will receive our special 2020 custom made medal with a trophy being awarded to the winner in each pool.
- Disciplines / categories:** The 5 level system will be in operation to ensure everyone, of all abilities is included in this event. The organisers reserve the right to combined categories if necessary with the approval of team coach and in line with our best practice rules.
- Rules:** The tournament is held in accordance with the current SNJU Rules which are available under downloads on our website [www.snju.org](http://www.snju.org)
- Judogi Control:** All competitors must wear a white judogi and females must wear a white round neck, short sleeved t-shirt under their Judogi. Long hair must be tied up with a non-metal band.
- Insurance:** All competitors are responsible for their own insurance cover and must be a registered member of their respective association/federation. Proof of up to date membership is required for inspection at check/weight in.
- Media:** It is a condition of entry that the organisers may take photos and said photos can/will be used for promotional purposes on website and social media.
- Liability:** The organisers, their associates and sponsors except no responsibility for any loss or injury to any one during their stay with us.
- Airport Transfer:** Buses will be made available for airport transfers on Thursday 14th at set times. There is a small fee of €5 each way and the balance for the service will be made by us. If you arrive outside of the set times you can wait for the next bus or use public transport which is approx. €17 each way.
