Important Entry Information

We want to make your entry process as simply as possible while maintaining the required permissions and parental consent for all players.

A group/club entry will be taken by the head coach via email using the excel sheet included, however an individual form must be filled out and signed for each player entering our tournament and presented a check-in on the day of event.

Other important information

- Closing date for entries is **Friday 11th October** or when our maximum entry level is achieved — No entries will be accepted once either has been reached
- **ALL** information must be supplied on the entry form
- Entry fee is €20
- Entry fee can be paid by bank transfer at the time of entry submission or in cash on the day.
- Please note if you opt to pay cash on the day you must pay for ALL players entered whether they attend or not.
- All players will be rewarded for their efforts
- Check-in time starts at 9.30am and closes at 10.00am - competition will start 10.30am
- All competitors are responsible for their own insurance cover and must be a registered member of their respective association/federation. Proof of up to date membership is required for inspection at check/weight in.
- The organisers, their associates and sponsors except no responsibility for any loss or injury on the day of competition.
- It is a condition of entry that the organisers may take photos and videos and said photos/videos can/will be used for promotional purposes on websites and social media platforms.
- All competitors must wear a **WHITE** judogi and females must wear a white round neck, short sleeved t/shirt under their Judogi. Long hair must be tied up with a non-metal band (male & female)
- Current IJF rules will apply in all mainstream categories
- Current international adaptive rules will apply for all Judo Assist categories
- Our event will be a fully autism friendly event.
- There will be a running order screen in front of each tatami
- Each of the control tables will be colour coded to make it easier for players & coaches
- Names and country will be display on scoreboards
- Specially trained referees will ensure a positive experience for all athletes taking part.
